## Coleham Primary School's responsibilities

- Create a safe, happy, learning environment where students feel safe and cared for and are willing to engage with their learning.
- Provide a broad and balanced creative curriculum which engages and inspires learners and is appropriate to the needs of every pupil.
- Promote high standards, good behaviour and mutual respect.
- Encourage our pupils to do their best at all times.
- Provide extra-curricular activities to develop the broader skills that will assist with the personal, social, physical and cultural development of pupils.
- Respect the rights and needs of all staff, parents and children associated with the school.
- Build a three-way partnership between itself, pupils and parents which is open, supportive and provides full communications regarding school life and our pupils progress.

- Be good people by behaving sensibly and respectfully, and showing kindness, consideration and the willing to give, in order to make the right choices for themselves and others.
- Be proud of themselves and their school and try their best at all times.

## Parent's responsibilities

- Encourage their child to work towards the school's expectations (see above).
- Engage with the school in a respectful, co-operative manner, having reasonable expectations of response to concerns in terms of time and outcome.
- Inform the school of any change in their child's circumstances or speak to a member of staff if you have any concerns or problems regarding any aspect of their child's schooling.
- Endeavour to support the school and your child by attending any information meetings arranged by the school.
- Share their praise for the school where they feel it is warranted.
- Send your child to school on time for an 8:50am start. Commit to 100% attendance by not seeking to remove their children from school during term time, except under exceptional circumstances.
