To take part in an appraisal process which uses the Teachers' Standards to improve teachers' practice at all career stages. 3. Undertake duties and tasks under the reasonable direction of the Head teacher. 	
Additional Responsibilities	
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be responsible for an area of central display as designated by your key stage co-ordinator. 2. To be willing to lead extra-curricular activity and attend some school events e.g. school production. 3. To have the ability to lead on a curriculum area.
