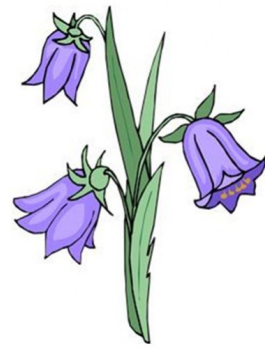




## Summer Term 2018



In Literacy this term the children will learn about the features of non-fiction texts linked to mini-beasts such as snails, ladybirds and spiders. They will write instructions and information leaflets.

In the second part of this term the children will use their imagination and write creatively about fantasy worlds.

In Forest School sessions the children will learn to name, describe and compare the structure of common mini beasts such as snails, spiders, butterflies etc. In Science the children will continue to learn about changes across the four seasons. They will learn to identify the signs of Spring and Summer. They will be able to describe the weather and talk about how day length varies.

The children will learn to identify and name several common wild flowers, garden flowers and trees. They will learn about the structure of plants and trees and the function of parts such as roots, leaves, stems etc. They will be investigating what plants need to grow healthily. In D.T they will design and make moving pictures and make fruit smoothies using summer fruits.

Our Art and Design work will reflect these activities. The children will be encouraged to study paintings of gardens painted by Monet and natural sculptures made by Andy Goldsworthy. Then they will make their own natural sculptures and drawings/paintings of gardens, flowers and trees.

In R.E the children will learn about different places of worship and will visit St. Mary's Church in the town centre.
