This year at Coleham School, we would like to hold an **International Day** again - on **Tuesday 2nd October**. This will be a day during which pupils in all year groups will take part in lessons and activities which celebrate international cultures and diversity within our school community.

Dressing up

As last year, we would like pupils to **dress up** in the colours of a flag from any country around the world. Alternatively, some children might like to wear traditional dress relating to a particular culture with which they have links with.

International food

If possible, we would like parents/guardians to prepare some international food for the children to sample on the day. It would make it very exciting for the children to have a tasting session during their allotted class slot in the afternoon. If you are able to contribute a cultural dish for our **International Taster Kitchen**, simply bring it along on the day and hand it to your child's class teacher. Could we also please ask a few things of you to ensure the safety of every child and to make the tasting a logistically smooth process:


- 1) No nuts to be used in any dish
- 2) No sesame seeds to be used in any dish
- 3) ALL ingredients to be written on a label so we can cater for children with allergies
- 4) Label the food with your child's NAME and CLASS so that we can aim to make sure that your child gets to taste their own dish
- 5) **FINGER FOOD ONLY** – cut into portions

Please note, food will be left at room temperature until it is tasted in the afternoon, so please bear this in mind when selecting what food to bring in.

In addition, there will be an **International lunchtime menu** to carry the theme through the day and a whole school **Flamenco concert** in the morning assembly. KS2 will get the chance to do a Flamenco dancing workshop during the afternoon. We hope you all agree that it will be a fun and enriching experience for all!
