During your child's first year of school, the Public Health Nursing Service (formally school nursing) offers a height and weight measurement to every reception child. A consent form was included in your child's Starter Pack which you will have already returned to school.

This letter is a reminder that your child's measurements will also be used to inform the National Child Measurement Programme (NCMP) and a leaflet has been sent to school which explains the NCMP in more depth. If you would like to discuss your child being measured or if your child has a medical condition that you think may affect their measurements, please do not hesitate to contact the NCMP advice line below, leave a message and a qualified nurse will contact you within 5 working days.
