

## Year One Termly Newsletter

Spring 2019



In Year One, this term, we will be learning about toys children played with in the past. We shall visit Weston Park Toy Museum to take part in a variety of exciting activities.

In D&T we will be making a cup and ball. We will also design and make moving pictures based on Traditional Tales.

In Science we will learn to identify and compare a variety of materials. We will group them according to their properties. We will carry out fair tests and investigate the properties of chosen materials. We will focus on predicting what will happen, turning ideas into a form that can be tested and making observations and comparisons.

During our weekly Forest School sessions we will continue observing seasonal changes and will be focusing on signs of Winter then Spring.

In Literacy we will read and write our own versions of Traditional Tales such as Jack and the Beanstalk and Little Red Hen. We will learn about animals from hot and cold parts of the world by reading non-fiction books. Then we will compose and write our own information texts.

In ICT the children will learn how to use Espresso coding to write simple algorithms.

Our Maths work will focus on addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, place value, money and measure.
