We understand how important communication between parents and teachers is and aim to maintain the strong home-school links that you are used to. If you would like to contact us, you can email the school office, write a message in your child's reading diary or speak to a member of staff on the playground at the start or end of the day. We will post learning updates via Class Dojo and even more frequent updates can be found on the school website.

Reading Books

Children will continue to bring home a school reading book to read at home. Please spend 10 minutes each day either listening to your child read or enjoy reading a story to them. The discussion about the texts you have enjoyed together is invaluable. Please record each of your reads in your Reading Diary. We will be looking at reading diaries weekly in school to see how you are getting on with recording at least 5 home reads. Reading *for Pleasure* is a big focus in school and will help the children achieve in many other areas. As a class we enjoy a class story at the end of each day.

<u>Our Topic</u>

Throughout this term we will be covering a variety of topics, where appropriate we will make links between them. We will be covering the following areas in our learning over the weeks ahead.

English: writing based on the themes of fairy tales, reports and poetry

Maths: numbers 10-100, calculations within 20,

beginning to add and subtract two-digit numbers and beginning to explore the concept of multiplication **Science**: materials and their properties

Geography: the seven continents

History: Guy Fawkes and the Gunpowder Plot **RE**: finding out about the practices of the Islamic faith and considering the importance of Christmas for Christians

Support at Home

Spellings in year 2 are taught throughout the week and we are not sending home lists of words to spell in weekly tests. However, it would be useful to practise the common exception words at home; the list will be sent home in your child's book bag. These are words that are not easily broken down by the children using their phonetic knowledge.

When reading with your child, please remember to ask questions about the content of the text as well as focusing on fluency and accuracy. As well as regular reading, please help your child with their knowledge of the x2, x5 and x10. Children can continue to use their TT Rockstars and Numbots Apps to support their learning of maths for 10 minutes, 3-5 times a week.
