Reading Books

Children will continue to bring home a school reading book to read at home. Please spend 10 minutes each day to either listen to your child read or enjoy reading a story to them. Please record this in the Reading Diary and read the comments by staff that have listened to your child read in school. Reading for Pleasure is a big focus in school and will help the children achieve in so many other areas.

When reading with your child, please remember to ask questions about the content of the text as well as focusing on fluency and accuracy.

Support at Home

Spellings in Year 2 are taught throughout the week and we are not sending home lists of words to spell in weekly tests. However, it would be useful to practise the common exception words at home—the list was sent home in your child's book bag in September. These are words that are not easily broken down by the children using their phonetic knowledge. As well as regular reading, please help your child with their x2, x5, x10, x3, x4 and x11 times tables. Children can continue to use their **TT Rockstars** app to practice these. Don't forget we have the **NumBots** app for you to use at home as well which uses the same username and password as TTRS.
