Autumn Term Curriculum

English: Using our topic The Blitz, we will be writing a recount and a newspaper report. We will then describe a setting and finally create a story to entertain an audience.

Maths: In maths, we will cover place value; four written calculation methods; fractions, decimals and percentages; properties of shape and angles.

Science: We will explore light followed by the topic animals including humans where we learn about the circulatory system and think about healthy lifestyle choices.

History/Geography: Our history will be focussed around World War 2 concentrating on The Blitz and evacuees. Our Geography will focus on map skills and world locational knowledge

Art/DT: We will explore graffiti art and find out about the street artist Banksy. We will also complete cookery based around food rationing which occurred at the time.

PE: Tag rugby, netball, football, cross country, sports hall athletics and dance.

RE: Creation and Science - are these ideas conflicting or complimentary? We will also investigate the reasons why some people believe in God.

Computing: Computer skills, e-safety and programming. **PSHE/RSE:** British Values, school values, staying safe and RSE French: Places around school, the definite and indefinite article and International Day.
