A message from the Year 6 Team

We will be attending *Crucial Crew* this term and the children will also have an opportunity to take part in *Bikeability* sessions. Spring Term Curriculum

English: We will continue to complete a variety of writing genres with a focus on grammar and punctuation.

Maths: In maths, we will continue to secure the children's knowledge with formal calculation methods; fractions; decimals and percentages; and geometry and measurement. We will also cover algebra, ratio/proportion and statistics.

Science: We will study evolution and inheritance and explore electricity.

History/Geography: We will study the ancient Maya in history and focus on climate change and mountains in geography.

Art/DT: Drawing and illustrations skills will be further improved with a focus on portraits. Children will also design and build a fairground ride.

RE: For Christians, what kind of king is Jesus? How does faith help people when life gets hard?

Computing: Programming skills, e-safety and computing in society.

PSHE: British Values - tolerance, the working world and first aid.

French: Numbers up to 100, food and café vocab, ordering an ice-cream and a tourism leaflet.
