Our Learning Luggage bags have arrived and are ready for you to borrow!

What is Learning Luggage?

Learning Luggage are bags of educational resources for you to borrow, take home and enjoy together with your child.

Each bag of resources have been chosen by a team of Early Years Professionals who understand the importance of play in the Early Years.

Each bag includes all the resources needed to enjoy what's inside, as well as a handbook to give you extra tips and tricks along the way...



Learning Luggage is organised into four themes:

- **Explore** - Resources to encourage exploration and finding out more about the world around us.
- **Create** - Activities to fuel imaginations and develop creativity. Allowing children the opportunity to express themselves through imaginative role play together at home!
- **Discover** - Open ended resources for you to explore and experiment with. Opportunities for you to invent, make, break and construct.
- **Co-operate** - Multiplayer activities and games, involving instructions, rules or competition to play together at home. Perfect for social development.

How does it work?

Learning Luggage bags are free for you to borrow and take home for a few days throughout the term. Each term, resources will be hand picked and selected for the appropriate themed bag. Every child will take turns to borrow each themed bag in turn. Prompt return of the bags is expected to ensure all child are given the same opportunity to access the resources.



How can I borrow a bag?

It's super easy to borrow a bag, all you need to do is complete the form provided and await your bag.

All we ask is that you share your experience with us on **Tapestry** by publishing a quick note or even some photos and videos. In class we will share these photos with the children who love sharing their experience with their peers.
