School Uniform Policy

Date of policy: Summer 2023



1. Aims

Coleham School has the following aims in relation to school uniform:

- it is inclusive to all pupils and religions;
- it is comfortable and practical for school activities;
- it is affordable keeping branded items to a minimum, easily available and there is a recycling scheme in place to re-love and re-home uniform;

2. Legislation

Our uniform policy complies with DFE statutory guidance on the [cost of school uniforms](#) and the Human Rights Act 1998 and Equality Act 2010.

3. Coleham School Uniform Required

- Plain white polo shirt
- Grey trousers, shorts, skirt or pinafore dress
- Blue checked dress/playsuit in summer weather (**Optional**)
- Coleham School navy blue sweater or cardigan with school emblem purchased from School Shop Direct.
- Black footwear (Required)
- Plain socks or tights (Black, Navy, Grey or White)

With the exception of the Coleham School Emblem Jumpers/Cardigans, school uniform can be purchased widely from suppliers of your choice.

Parents should purchase school jumpers and cardigans from the School Shop Direct. Optional items such as Book bags and Caps are also available. These items can be purchased online by visiting www.schoolshopdirect.co.uk or direct from their Shrewsbury store. We request that school backpacks are small please as our cloakroom space is very limited.

Outdoor Kit (For PE & Forest School)

- Plain red, yellow, green or blue T-shirts (see House colours below)
- Plain red, yellow, green or blue hoodies/zipped jackets or plain black/navy as an alternate option.
- Navy blue or black shorts, leggings and/or jogging bottoms
- Trainers

House Colours

Darwin-**Yellow**

Greyfriars-**Red**

Quarry-**Green**

Severn-**Blue**

On Forest School days the children should wear trousers to cover their legs and bring any waterproofs/wellingtons required.



Children should come into school wearing their outdoor kit on their PE/FOREST SCHOOL DAYS.

ALL CLOTHING SHOULD BE CLEARLY LABELLED WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME. Please encourage your child to take responsibility for looking after and be independent in looking after their belongings. The nature of 'Lost Property' in a school of this size is difficult.

Recycling Scheme

A helping hand

We quite understand that school jumpers can sometimes get lost or shrunk in the wash or left somewhere. So to help, we have our own stock of jumpers which are constantly recycled in our school community. We have a box in each corridor which children can access whenever they need to, no questions asked. Please just ask a member of staff if you would like an extra jumper to keep or borrow.

If you have any Coleham School sweaters or cardigans that you no longer require and would like to re-home, please drop these at the school office for us to re-distribute in school.

Our 'Drop and Swop' scheme regularly recycles different items including uniform in school which will be advertised.

4. Review

The Local Governing Body will review this policy at appropriate intervals to ensure that uniform is still fit for purpose.
